Re: A "Win-Win-Win" Association

Dear Attorney:

In the past few years I have been focusing on personal injury cases. Almost all of my cases come from attorney referrals.

My experience teaches that when a general practitioner teams up with an effective personal injury attorney, a "win-win-win" result ensues, and all benefit: the local lawyer; the litigator; and most importantly, the client.

Conversely, I have also witnessed the aftermath of a sole practitioner trying to handle a catastrophic case without adequate resources. The earlier a good team is assembled, the greater the chance of a good outcome.

Some referring lawyers stay heavily involved in the case through trial. The Idaho Rules of Professional Conduct require that fee split arrangements be done with the client's consent and commensurate with the efforts of both attorneys.

I have had great results working with fellow Idaho lawyers. I have tried cases in every North Idaho courthouse from Bonners Ferry to Lewiston. In addition, over the last decade I have taught trial advocacy and evidence at the University of Idaho College of Law. I am an ITLA certified civil trial specialist. I also now serve as President of the Idaho State Bar.
